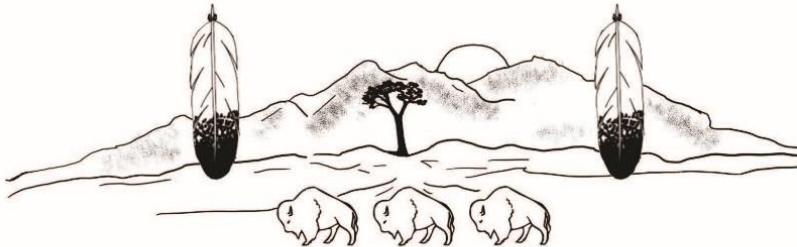


# Southern Ute Indian Tribe

The Sundance ceremony, conducted once a year in the middle of the summer, is the most important spiritual ceremony in the Ute tradition.

**ALL DANCERS, SINGERS, AND VISITORS WELCOME**  
**Because of the sacred nature and solemnity of the Sun Dance the rules of good manners and decorum must be observed by all, at all times.**

- 1. The entrance to the Medicine Lodge should have a clear passage at all times.**
- 2. Children should not be allowed to play around the Medicine Lodge.**
- 3. Women on their menstrual cycle or pregnant are not permitted on Sun Dance Grounds.**
- 4. Drugs and alcohol are not permitted on the Sun Dance grounds.**
- 5. Cameras, Tape/Video recorders, food and water are not allowed in or near the Medicine Lodge area.**
- 6. No metal chairs allowed inside the Medicine Lodge.**
- 7. No cell phones!!**
